# Special Funding for Hangman Creek:

## Apply by March 16, 2012



# \$53/acre

### If you're a producer in the Hangman Creek Watershed in Washington and Idaho, special funding is still available for:

#### Direct Seed (No-till), Stream Fencing and Off-stream Watering

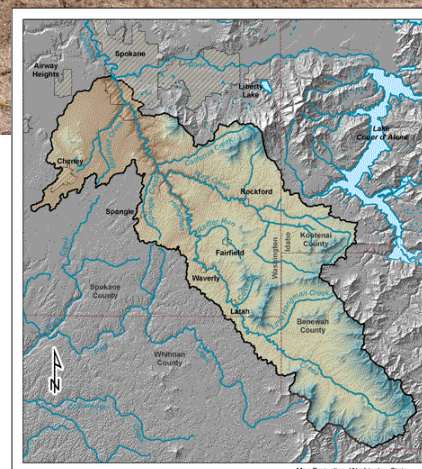
#### What's eligible?

Land not currently enrolled in the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP). Land that has been enrolled in some level of EQIP under the Mulch Till or Direct Seed Practices in the past **are**, however, eligible for the implementation of new practices on the land.

*Note: This is a special sign-up program and that you can apply for funding under this program as well as under the regular EQIP sign-up as long as the acres are not the same.*

#### Final Year Deadline: March 16, 2012

The time line is tight and applications have to be received by March 16 for the program. This is the **final year** of funding, so act now to receive money to implement conservation practices that will result in restoring the watershed.
